On January 8, 2002, President Bush signed into law the “No Child Left Behind Act” (NCLB). NCLB is designed to improve student achievement by increasing federal involvement in public education both at the state and local level. Beginning this year, NCLB will require significant changes to schools that receive Title I funding. Both Graysville and Springhill-Freeport Elementary Schools receive Title I funding and is covered under NCLB.

NCLB requires the following:

- Increased accountability for states, school districts and individual schools
- Greater choice for parents, especially those in low performing schools
- Greater flexibility for states and local education agencies in the use of federal dollars

Under NCLB, parents have a right to know the professional qualifications of their children’s teacher(s). This notice is to inform you of your rights for the following information about your child’s classroom teacher:

- Whether the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has licensed or qualified the teacher for the grades and subjects he or she teaches.
- Whether their teacher is teaching under an emergency permit or other provisional status through which state licensing criteria have been waived.
- The teacher’s college major, whether the teacher has any advanced degrees and, if so, the subject of the degrees.
- Whether any paraprofessionals provide services to your child and, if they do, their qualifications.
